**RE: Potential Rail Stoppage**

Dear Minister O'Regan:

On behalf of our collective food and agricultural memberships, we write to urge swift action to avert a rail strike, which could begin as soon as May 22. A rail stoppage would lead to shutdowns or slowdowns of rail-dependent facilities resulting in devastating consequences to national and global food security. If a negotiated solution fails to emerge, we request that you and your Cabinet colleagues take immediate action to prevent serious damage to the Canadian and U.S. economies.

We believe rail in Canada should be designated as an essential service. Our memberships rely on freight rail to move essential products across Canada and the U.S. and a disruption to Canadian National Railway (CN) and CPKC's rail service could ripple across North America. The impact of a strike would be particularly severe as trucking is not a viable option for many shippers due to their high-volume needs and the long distances for many of the movements.

Many facilities are continuous operations that require reliable, uninterrupted rail service to produce and deliver essential products to customers. In the event of an interruption, they quickly run out of storage capacity and incur shortages of incoming raw materials. In addition, shutdowns and restarts of such facilities are complex operations, meaning that even a short-term disruption could stop production for several weeks. Impact begins before May 22 as operations are wound down in preparation for having nowhere to go with product.

Operational railroads are essential on both sides of the border for the integrated North American supply chain. While we believe a negotiated solution is always the preferred outcome, the government should be prepared to move quickly if negotiations fail. We thank you for your responsiveness to this imminent supply chain issue.
